What we've been learning recently

Maths – We are learning place value to 100. We have been partitioning numbers into tens and ones using part whole models and counting in 10's forwards and backwards. We have been using our knowledge of numbers to 100 in practical activities with number lines, bingo and using resources to see what a number looks like.

Wider Curriculum – In computing we have been creating our own digital stories. We have planned our story to have a beginning, middle and an end with two characters, working with partners to create our own storylines. Following this, we set up story scenes and took photos in a sequence and shared the story with the class. We then used some editing techniques to change our photos.

PSHE – We have been looking at how our bodies change over time and as a class we really enjoyed the 'guess the baby' game. Thank you for providing baby photos, the children really enjoyed sharing them!
