What we've been learning recently

English – This week we have started our new unit around winter themed poetry. The children have been looking at a variety of shape poems and key features such as similes, alliteration and metaphors.

Maths – This week we have been using our multiplication facts of the different times tables. We have been using arrays to help us understand multiplications and inverse operations. The focus timetables for this week have been the 3 and 4 times tables.

Wider Curriculum – This week we have started our new DT topic - pneumatic devices. We have been looking at input forces and output forces and how this can be used to make toys. We have also been practicing how to draw diagrams.
