What we've been learning recently

English – We have been enjoying reading *Superworm* and bringing the story to life by acting out different parts and experimenting with character voices. We have also created our own rescue and made a story map to help us retell and sequence the events.

Maths – We have been working with numbers to 10. We started by sorting objects and counting a given number within 10 before moving on to counting forwards to 10 using a number track, adding one more, counting backwards from 10 and one less than a given number. We have been using different resources to help, including tens frames and counters.

Wider Curriculum – In Art, we have been sketching and experimenting with different lines and patterns we can make with pencils to create different effects. We spent time observing worms and other mini beasts before creating our own sketches (and some paintings). We were really impressed with the results!

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- In English, we will be reading *Room on the Broom*.
- We will be comparing numbers within 10, using the terms greater than, less than or equal to.
- We will be sketching teddy bears in Art, using the skills we have already learnt this week.
- In Science, we will be looking at the five different senses and carrying out some experiments.
