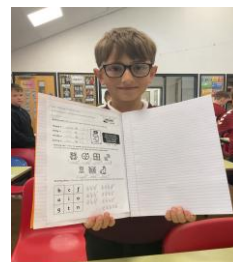
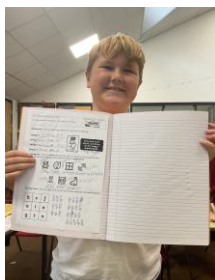




Year 4 News

What we've been learning recently

English – We have begun our new Year 4 'Place Value of Punctuation' (PVPG) English unit. In this, the children will develop a deeper understanding of grammar, sentence structure and punctuation, building on their knowledge from Year 3 and enabling them to write with greater accuracy, variety and control. We have been so impressed with how quickly they have been able to differentiate between the different types of nouns and their understanding of both regular and irregular verbs.

Maths – We have begun our place value learning journey. We have counted up to 1,000 on a number line, partitioned up to 10,000 and represented numbers both numerically and using words. We have been focusing lots on our presentation and using the squares in our books to help us layout our work and understanding the importance of showing our workings!

Wider Curriculum – In music, we are learning how to sing Mama Mia before using glockenspiels. In RE, our focus has been looking at how Hindus show worship in their everyday life. PE slots this term are basketball and gymnastics. Developing our basic passing skills and ball handling, alongside some super partner balances in gymnastics has been great to watch. Science this term focuses on living things and their habitats. We have loved learning where in the world different habitats can be found and what animals live in them.

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- Continuing our PVPG unit in English.
- Delving deeper into our science unit looking at living things and their habitats. We will look closer at the different habitats we can find in our local area.
- Continuing our understanding of place value before moving on to Roman numerals and rounding. We'll learn to round numbers up to 1,000 and explore some great ways to support our learning. Keep an eye (and ear!) out for our **Rounding Rap** – it's a cracker.
