What we've been learning recently

English – We have begun using our new writing scheme, Grammarsaurus. As part of our first unit, *Place Value: Grammar and Punctuation*, the children have been exploring different types of nouns. They have been learning to identify nouns within sentences and use them accurately in their own writing.

Maths – We have begun our Place Value learning journey. So far, the children have been learning to recognise and read numbers up to 1,000,000 and write numbers accurately to 1,000,000. They have also started exploring how to multiply and divide by 10. To help us remember what happens when multiplying by 10, we use the phrase, "*Think like Beyoncé: to the left, to the left!*" as the digits move one place to the left in the place value chart.

Wider Curriculum – We have been busy scientists, learning about the different kingdoms of living organisms. The children have begun exploring how scientists classify living things and will continue to develop their understanding of the various ways organisms can be grouped and identified.

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- Continue our PVPG unit in English, and apply to creative writing.
- In Maths, we'll be learning about negative numbers.
- Finishing our Science learning about classification.
- In music, we will be learning the song 'Happy' by Pharrell.
